The congregational council communicates its recommendation to the congregation and makes the updated constitution available for review by members at least 30 days prior to the congregational meeting.

The congregational council uses the most recent *Model Constitition* to bring the congregations constitution into compliance.

This can be done by the Council or a designated constitution committee.

At the duly called congregational meeting the members vote on only the "conformity" changes to the constitution as listed


A simple majority is required to move forward.
